Since we began production in 1966, ingenuity has always been at the centre of our methods, fuelling our passion for whisky making. What makes us unique is our Straight Neck pot stills - installed during the distillery's founding and key in producing our signature tropical fruit character, encapsulated perfectly in this remarkable single malt whisky.

A whisky this special demanded a presentation to match. In homage to our unique stills, a careful selection of copper finishings and touches have been woven into the design of the display cabinet and decanter.

CRAFTED BY EXPERT HANDS...

Master Blender, Michael Henry joined the Loch Lomond Distillery in 2007. Our oldest and rarest casks remain exclusively under his personal care, including this remarkable release.

11 Our stills are synonymous with signature fruity notes. The 50 Year Old has been granted the time to truly concentrate that character, resulting in a rich, tropical fruit flavour. The decision to re-cask a whisky of this quality and age is not taken lightly, however the complexity and depth of flavour brought by the first fill Bourbon and the Oloroso sherry casks have made this a truly special single malt.

The expectations are high when you are working with liquid as special and scarce, but it is a true honour to be the final custodian of such a special piece of history.



DEEP WATERS FORM TIMELESS FLAVOURS

NOSE Refreshing orange and mint, sweet fruit of grilled peach and mango, nutmeg.

PALATE Beautiful depth of flavour, melted brown sugar with juicy apricot, tangy orange marmalade and dark fruits, plum and cherry before creamy vanilla fudge and warming cinnamon spice.

FINISH Long, mouth-watering

watermelon and kiwi with a grapefruit citrus edge, some green tea and lasting wood spice.

DISTILLATION Distilled 29/03/1973; collected at high Strength; 100% unpeated malted barley.

MATURATION Original cask: refill American Oak hogsheads: recasked into first fill Bourbon in 08/2011: recasked into first fill Oloroso hogsheads 10/2017.

The natural oak finish nods to Michael's careful selection of casks and the beauty of the surrounding forests of the Trossachs. A 5cl miniature and hardback book also accompany each decanter.

Finally, our most skilled partners have etched and applied the **contours** of the loch throughout the design, paying deepest respect to the hidden depths of our surroundings, our capabilities and our distillery's history.
