



## Collaboration Drop 02: Dingle



At Turntable Spirits we venture beyond the borders of expectations, experimenting with the limit of flavour and creativity to break new ground in whisky excellence.

Our collaboration series is an opportunity to work with like minded teams to flip the record on ordinary.

Two hundred years ago, Ireland had over a hundred officially recognized distilleries; by the turn of this century there were two. Dingle was the first independent distillery to release single pot still whiskey in over a century – the spark that ignited today's Irish whiskey renaissance.

For this blend, we have focused on the spice notes from Dingle single pot still whiskey in oloroso casks and accentuated these further by marrying with Scotch whisky matured in a combination of ex-rye barrels, PX sherry puncheons and 1st fill bourbon barrels. Bottled at 52% to retain the vibrancy of flavour. Ireland meets Scotland.
